

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Professeur d'histoire de l'Église ancienne à l'Université de Tromsø en Norvège et prêtre, l'A. reprend une nouvelle fois le dossier de l'eucharistie chez Tertullien et Cyprien. Il souligne d'emblée, et avec raison, les limites que «la discipline de l'arcane» impose à la loquacité des sources disponibles, puis traite successivement de Tertullien et de Cyprien. L'exposé est équilibré et cite souvent les sources, en recourant curieusement au *CSEL*, et non au *CCSL*. L'A. tient une saine distance par rapport aux controverses théologiques des époques moderne et contemporaine où ces auteurs furent mobilisés comme munitions. P. 936, on corrigera une erreur sur le gentilice de Tertullien, *Septimius* (et non *Septimus*), et une autre sur la formule onomastique probable de Cyprien, *Caecilius Cyprianus qui et Thascius* (et non *Thascius Caecilius Cyprianus*). La connaissance de la bibliographie est parfois limitée, et des études importantes comme la monographie de dom Dekkers sur Tertullien ou la contribution de M. Klöckener dans *Præx Eucharistica* (*CTC* 06, 90) sont ignorées. On pourra comparer utilement cette analyse avec celle, récente, de Paul Mattei (*CTC* 14, 55).
